

LION BRAND® WOOL-EASE® SHIRA'S HAT 2020



SIZE
Finished Circumference
About 20 in. (51 cm)

Finished Height
About 9 in. (23 cm)



GAUGE
Crochet 15 sts over Rows 1-5 of
pattern = about 4 in. (10 cm)

Knit 20 sts over Rows 1-5 of
pattern = about 4 in. (10 cm)

Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® WOOL-EASE® (Art. #620)
#115 Blue Mist 2 balls
- LION BRAND® crochet hook I-9 (5.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® knitting needles
size 7 (4.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® cable needle
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

NOTES

1. The Hat is made from 2 separate pieces that are sewn together. Our Hat was made with one crochet piece and one knit piece -but you can make your own hat with 2 knit pieces or 2 crochet pieces if you prefer.
2. Each piece is made with cables. The cables are not difficult, just follow the directions carefully!
3. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a diagram for the crochet piece.



EASY

CROCHET STITCH EXPLANATIONS

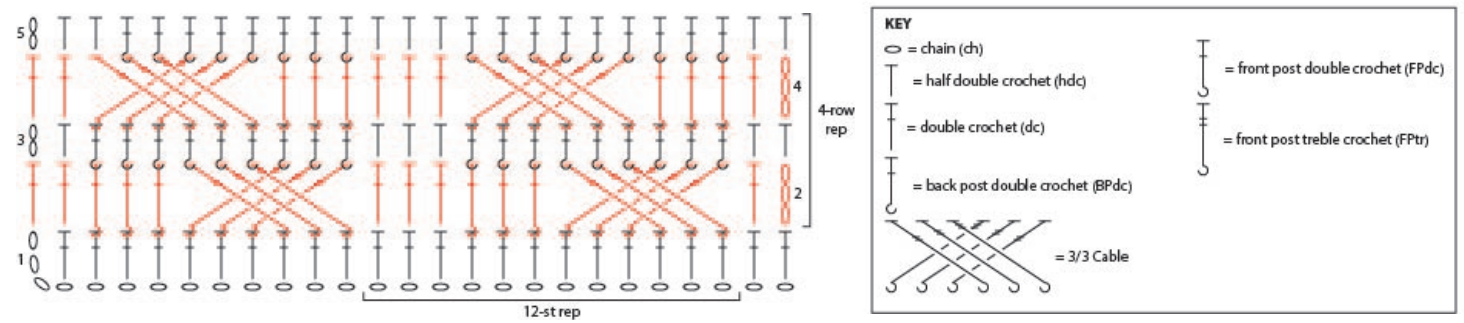
BPDC (back post double crochet) Yarn over, insert hook from back to front then to back, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Skip st in front of the BPDC.

dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

FPDC (front post double crochet) Yarn over, insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Skip st behind the FPDC.

FPTR (front post treble crochet) Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back then to front again, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times. Skip st behind the FPTR.

3/3 Cable Sk next 3 sts, FPTR around each of next 3 sts; working in front of the 3 sts just made, FPTR around each of the 3 skipped sts.



KNIT STITCH EXPLANATION

3/3 Cable Slip next 3 sts to a cable needle and hold in front, k3, then k3 from cable needle.

CROCHET PIECE

Ch 39.

Row 1 (WS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc) and in each ch across – you'll have 37 dc.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next st, *3/3 cable, FPDC around each of next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts; rep from * once more, 3/3 cable, FPDC around each of next 3 sts, dc in next st, dc in top of beg ch – you will have three 3/3 cables in this row.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in next st, BPDC around each of next 9 sts, *hdc in next 3 sts, BPDC around each of next 9 sts; rep from * once more, hdc in next st, hdc in top of beg ch.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next st, *FPDC around each of next 3 sts, 3/3 cable, dc in next 3 sts; rep from * once more, FPDC around each of next 3 sts, 3/3 cable, dc in next st, dc in top of beg ch.

Row 5: Rep Row 3.
Rep Rows 2-5 until piece measures about 9 1/2 in. (24 cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Next Row: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across – 37 dc.

Last Row: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, *dc2tog; rep from * across – you'll have 19 dc.

Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then weave in and out of sts along the last row. Pull to gather and knot.

KNIT PIECE

Cast on 50 sts.

Row 1 (RS): P9, (K6, p7) twice, k6, p9.

Row 2 and all WS Rows: Knit the knits and purl the purls as they appear.

Row 3: Rep Row 1.

Row 5: P9, (3/3 cable over next 6 sts, p7) twice, 3/3 cable over next 6 sts, p9.

Rows 7 and 9: Rep Row 1.

Row 11: Rep Row 5.

Rows 13 and 15: Rep Row 1.

Row 16: Rep Row 2.
Rep Rows 1-16 until piece measures about 9 1/2 in. (24 cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Last Row: K2tog across – you'll have 25 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into the blunt needle, then draw through

remaining sts, pull to gather and knot.

FINISHING

Sew sides of knit and crochet pieces together to make a ring. With yarn threaded doubled into blunt needle, sew in and out around gathered top of Hat, pull to close opening at top of Hat and knot securely.

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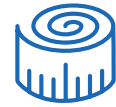

LION BRAND® JEANS® FINLEY HAT



SIZE

Finished Circumference
About 15 in. (38 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes



GAUGE

25 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm)
in k2, p2 rib slightly stretched
Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® JEANS® (Art. #505)
(Yarn weight CYC #4) #109 Stonewash 1 Ball
- LION BRAND® Double Pointed Needles
Size 6 (4 mm)
- LION BRAND® Stitch Markers
- LION BRAND® Large-Eyed Blunt Needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle
size 6 (4 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long

NOTES

1. Hat is worked in one piece in the round, beginning on a circular needle then changing to double-pointed needles.
2. Top of Hat is shaped by working simple decreases.

With circular needle, cast on 92 sts. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.
Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * around. Rep Rnd 1 until piece measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beg.

Shape Top of Hat

Note: When working Rnd 1, you'll be decreasing sts. Change to double-pointed needles as you work Rnd 1. Be sure to move your st marker onto the double-pointed needles as well!

Rnd 1: *K2, p2tog; rep from * to end of round – you will have 69 sts.

Rnd 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts around.

Rnd 3: *K2tog, p1; rep from * around – 46 sts.

Rnd 4: K the knit sts and p the purl sts around to last st. Slip last st to your right hand needle, remove end of rnd marker, slip last st back onto your left hand needle and replace marker.

Rnd 5: K2tog around – 23 sts.

Rnd 6: Knit.
Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then draw through remaining sts. Pull to close top of Hat, then knot.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

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LION BRAND® WOOL-EASE® THICK & QUICK® MARLO HAT



SIZES
Child Small (Child Medium, Child Large/Adult)
Finished Circumference About 16 (18, 20) in. (40.5 (45.5, 51) cm), will fit a range of sizes.
Finished Height About 8 1/2 (10 1/2, 11) in. (21.5 (26.5, 28) cm), with lower band unfolded; about 6 1/2 (8, 8 1/2) in. (16.5 (20.5, 21.5) cm), with lower band folded up



GAUGE
8 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm).
Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® WOOL-EASE® THICK & QUICK® (Art. #640) (Yarn weight CYC #6) #114 Denim 1 (1, 1) ball
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size N-13 (9 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To make the pattern easy to follow, we've color coded the sizes.

NOTES

1. Hat is worked from lower edge upwards.
2. A long band of single crochet (sc) worked in back loops only is worked first for lower ribbing.
3. Stitches are worked evenly along one long edge of lower ribbing then Hat is worked in continuous rounds (spiral) upwards.
4. Decreases (sc2tog) are worked to shape top of Hat.

STITCH EXPLANATION

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

Lower Band

Leaving a long beg tail, ch 5 (6, 6).
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 4 (5, 5) sc in this row.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st across.
Rep Row 2 until piece, slightly stretched, measures about 16 (18, 20) in. (40.5 (45.5, 51) cm) from beg.

Hat

Rnd 1: Ch 1, do not turn, working in ends of rows along long edge of lower band, work 32 (36, 40) sc as evenly spaced as possible along edge.
Bend band into a circle, bringing short ends together. To beg working in rnds, work the first st of Rnd 2 into the first st of Rnd 1. Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.
Rnd 2: Sc in each st to end of rnd.
Rep Rnd 2 until piece measures about 8 (10, 10 1/2) in. (20.5 (25.5, 26.5) cm) from beg.

Shape Top of Hat

Rnd 1: *Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – 24 (27, 30) sc.
Rnd 2: *Sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – 16 (18, 20) sc.
Rnd 3: Sc in each st to end of rnd.
Rnd 4: *Sc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – 8 (9, 10) sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail into blunt needle and weave needle in and out of sts of last rnd. Pull to close opening at top of Hat. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Thread beg yarn tail into blunt needle and sew edges of lower band together.
Weave in ends.

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LION BRAND® HOMETOWN RAMSEY HAT



SIZES
Child Small (Child Medium, Child Large/Adult)

Finished Circumference About 16 (18, 20) in. (40.5 (45.5, 51) cm), will fit a range of sizes.

Finished Height About 8 1/2 (10 1/2, 12) in. (21.5 (26.5, 30.5) cm), with lower band unfolded; about 6 1/2 (8, 8 1/2) in. (16.5 (20.5, 21.5) cm), with lower band folded up



GAUGE
9 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).
Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® HOMETOWN (Art.#135) (Yarn weight CYC #6) #111 San Diego Navy 1 (1, 1) ball
- LION BRAND® knitting needles size 13 (9 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To make the pattern easy to follow, we've color coded the sizes.

NOTES

1. Hat is worked back and forth in rows then seamed.
2. Decreases (k2tog) are worked to shape top of Hat.

Cast on 38 (42, 46).

Row 1 (RS): K2, *p2, k2; rep from * to end of row.
Row 2: P2, *k2, p2; rep from * to end of row.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 2 (2 1/2, 2 1/2) in. (5 (6.5, 6.5) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Decrease Row (RS): Knit, working 2 (1, 1) decreases (k2tog) evenly spaced across row – you will have 36 (41, 45) sts in this row.

Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 8 (10, 10 1/2) in. (20.5 (25.5, 26.5) cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Top of Hat

Row 1 (RS): *K3 (4, 6), k2tog; rep from * 5 (5, 4) more times, k to end of row – 30 (35, 40) sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: *K3, k2tog; rep from * to end of row – 24 (28, 32) sts.

Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: *K2, k2tog; rep from * to end of row – 18

(21, 24) sts.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: *K1, k2tog; rep from * to end of row – 12 (14, 16) sts.

Row 8: Purl.

Row 9: *K2tog; rep from * to end of row – 6 (7, 8) sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread tail into blunt needle and then through remaining sts. Pull to gather top of Hat. Knot securely then sew side edges together to form Hat.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

St st = Stockinette stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side

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LION BRAND® JEANS® KAI HAT



SIZE
Finished Circumference
About 20 in. (51 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Finished Height
About 11 in. (28 cm).



GAUGE
16 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm)
Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND®JEANS® (Art. #505) (Yarn weight CYC #4) # 109 Stonewash 1 ball
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

NOTES

1. A long band is worked first for lower ribbing, then the Hat is worked from lower edge upwards along one long edge of ribbing..
2. The top of the Hat is shaped with decreases.

STITCH EXPLANATION

hdc2tog (hdc 2 together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

Lower Band

Leaving a long beg tail, ch 13.

Row 1: Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 12 hdc in this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (not counts as st), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each st across. Rep Row 2 until piece, when slightly stretched, measures about 20 in. (51) cm) from beg.

Hat

Rnd 1: Sew ends of band together.

Ch 1, do not turn, working in ends of rows along long edge of band, work 80 sc evenly spaced along edge. Join with a sl st to first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st throughout this pattern), do not turn, hdc in each st around, join with sl st in beginning ch. Repeat Rnd 2 until piece measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beginning.

Shape Top of Hat

As you shape the top of the Hat, continue to join end of each rnd with a slip st.

Rnd 1: Ch 2, *hdc in next 2 sts, hdc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – you'll have 60 hdc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, *hdc in next st, hdc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – 40 hdc.

Rnds 3 and 4: Ch 2, *hdc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail into blunt needle and weave needle through remaining 10 sts of last rnd. Pull to close opening at top of Hat. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

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LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH ANTI-PILLING™ FRANKIE STRIPED HAT



SIZE
Finished Circumference
About 20 in. (51 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Finished Height
About 9 in. (22.5) cm



GAUGE
18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm)
Be sure to check your gauge.

- MATERIALS**
- LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH ANTI-PILLING™ (Art. #202) (Yarn weight CYC #4)
#111 Royal Blue 1 ball (A)
#106 Baby Blue 1 ball (B)
 - LION BRAND® stitch markers
 - LION BRAND® pom-pom maker
 - LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS
Circular knitting needle size 8 (5 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long
Double pointed knitting needles size 8 (5 mm), set of 5

- NOTES**
1. Hat is worked in one piece in the round, beginning on a circular needle and then changing to double pointed needles when sts have been sufficiently decreased.
 2. A ribbed edge is worked, then Hat is worked in St St (in A) and Stripe Garter St (in B).
 3. The top of the Hat is shaped with decreases.
 4. Pom-pom is made separately and then tied to top of Hat.

With circular needle and A, cast on 90 sts. Join, being careful not to twist. Place marker for beginning of rnd.

Ribbed edge
Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd. Rep Rnd 1 for ribbed edge until piece measures about 2 1/2 in. (6 cm) from beginning.

Rnds 1-2: With A, knit.

Note
When working one of the color rnds of the Hat, carry other color up the inside of the Hat to the next rnd on which you'll use it.

Rnd 3: With B, knit.
Rnd 4: With B, purl.
Rnds 5-6: With A, knit.
Rnds 7-36: Rep Rnds 1-6.

Shape Top of Hat
Rnd 1 (Decrease Rnd): *With A, k3, k2tog; rep from * around – you'll have 72 sts.

Note
As you work Rnd 2, change to double pointed needles (by simply knitting onto one double pointed needed at a time) to finish working the top of the Hat.

Rnd 2: With A knit.
Rnd 3 (Decrease Rnd): *With B, k2, k2tog; rep from * around – 54 sts.
Rnd 4: With B purl.
Rnd 5 (Decrease Rnd): *With A, k1, k2tog; rep from * around – 36 sts.
Rnds 6 and 8: Rep Rnd 2.
Rnd 7 (Decrease Rnd): *With A, k2tog; rep from * around – 18 sts.
Rnd 9 (Decrease Rnd): *With A, k2tog; rep from * around – 9 sts.

Cut yarn leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail into blunt needle and draw through remaining sts. Pull to close opening at top of Hat. Knot securely.

FINISHING
With B and following package instructions, make a medium size pom-pom. Tie pom-pom to top of Hat.

Weave in ends.

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LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH ANTI-PILLING™ SKYLAR HAT



SIZE
Finished Circumference
About 20 in. (51 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Finished Height
About 9 in. (22.5) cm



GAUGE
15 dc = about 4 in. (10 cm)
Be sure to check your gauge.

- MATERIALS**
- LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH ANTI-PILLING® (Art. #202) (Yarn weight CYC #4)
109 Steel Blue 1 ball (A)
210 Fairview 1 ball (B)
 - LION BRAND® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
 - LION BRAND® stitch markers
 - LION BRAND® pom-pom maker
 - LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

- NOTES**
1. Lower band is worked first, then Hat is worked directly onto the band.
 2. Two colors of yarn are used. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete the st. You needn't cut old color, just carry it up the WS of the piece.
 3. The top of the Hat is shaped with decreases.
 4. Pom-pom is made separately, then tied to Hat.

STITCH EXPLANATION
dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

Lower Band
With A and leaving a long beginning yarn tail, ch 11.
Row 1: Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you'll have 10 hdc.
Row 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each st across.

Rep Row 2 until piece, when slightly stretched, measures about 20 in. (51 cm) from beginning.

Hat
Rnd 1: Ch 1, do not turn, working in ends of rows along one long edge of band, work 76 sc evenly spaced along edge, changing to B in last st. Join with sl st to first sc.
Rnd 2: With B, sl st in each st to end of rnd, changing to A in last st. Join with sl st.
Rnd 3: With A, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each sc of Rnd 1 around; join with sl st to top of beg ch-3, join with sl st.
Rnd 4: With A, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each st around, change to B in last st and join with st st.
Rnds 5-16: Rep Rnds 2-4.
Rnd 17: Rep Rnd 2.

Shape Top of Hat
Rnd 1 (Decreade Rnd): With A, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next st, dc2tog, *dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd join with sl st – you'll have 57 sts.

Rnd 2: With A, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each st around, change to B in last st and join with st st.
Rnd 3: With B, sl st in each st to end of rnd, changing to A in last st. Join with sl st.
Rnd 4 (Decrease Rnd): With A, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc2tog, *dc in next st, dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd, join with sl st – 38 sts.
Rnds 5 and 6: Rep Rnds 2-3 (of Shape Top of Hat) – 38 sts.
Rnd 7 (Decrease Rnd): With A, ch2, dc2tog around – 19 sts.
Rnds 8 and 9: Rep Rnds 2-3 (of Shape Top of Hat) – 19 sts.
Rnd 10: With A, ch 3 (counts as first dc) *dc2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – 10 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail into blunt needle and weave needle in and out of sts of last rnd. Pull to close opening at top of Hat and knot securely.
Thread beginning yarn tail into blunt needle and sew first row of band to last row of band.

FINISHING
With B and following package instructions, make a medium size pom-pom. Tie pom-pom to top of Hat.

Weave in ends.

- p** = purl
- rep** = repeat
- rnd(s)** = round (s)
- st (s)** = stitch (es)

SIZE
Finished Circumference
About 20 in. (51 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Finished Height
About 9 in. (22.5) cm



GAUGE
20 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm)
Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® JEANS® (Art. #505)
(Yarn weight CYC #6)
108 Brand New 1 ball (A)
105 Faded 1 ball (B)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® pom-pom maker
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long
Double pointed knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm), set of 5

NOTES

1. Hat is worked in one piece in the round, beginning on a circular needle and then changing to double pointed needles when sts have been sufficiently decreased.
2. A ribbed edge is worked, then Hat is worked in St st worked in the rnd (knit every rnd) with 2 colors of yarn.
3. The top of the Hat is shaped with decreases.
4. Pom-pom is made separately and then tied to top of Hat.

HAT

With A cast on 100 sts.
Join, being careful not to twist.
Place marker for beginning of rnd.

Ribbed edge

Rnd 1 (RS): * K2, p2; rep from * to end of rnd.
Rep Rnd 1 for ribbed edge until piece measures about 2 1/2 in. (6 cm) from beginning.

Heart pattern

Rnds 1 and 2: With A, knit.

Note

Rnds 3 and 7 are worked with 2 colors of yarn.
Carry the yarn color not in use across the inside of the Hat.

When working solid A color rnds of the Hat, carry B up the inside of the Hat to the next rnd on which you'll use it.

Rnd 3: *With A, k3, with B, k1; rep from * around.

Rnds 4-6: With A, knit.

Rnd 7: *With A, k1, with B, k1, with A, k2; rep from * around.

Rnd 8: With A, knit.

Rnds 9-40: Rep Rnds 1-8.

Shape Top of Hat

Rnd 1 (Decrease Rnd): With A, *k2, k2tog; rep from * around – you'll have 75 sts.

Note

As you work Rnd 2, change to double pointed needles (by simply knitting onto one double pointed needed at a time) to finish working the top of the Hat.

Rnd 2: With A knit.

Rnd 3 (Decrease Rnd): *With A, k1, with B k2tog; rep from * around – 50 sts.

Rnds 4 and 6: Rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 5 (Decrease Rnd): *With A, k2tog; rep from * around – 25 sts.

Rnd 7 (Decrease Rnd): *With A, K2tog; rep from * around to last st, knit last st – 13 sts remain.

Rnd 8: With A, knit.

Cut yarn leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail into blunt needle and draw through remaining sts. Pull to close opening at top of Hat. Knot securely.

FINISHING

With B and following package instructions, make a medium size pom-pom. Tie pom-pom to top of Hat.

Weave in ends.

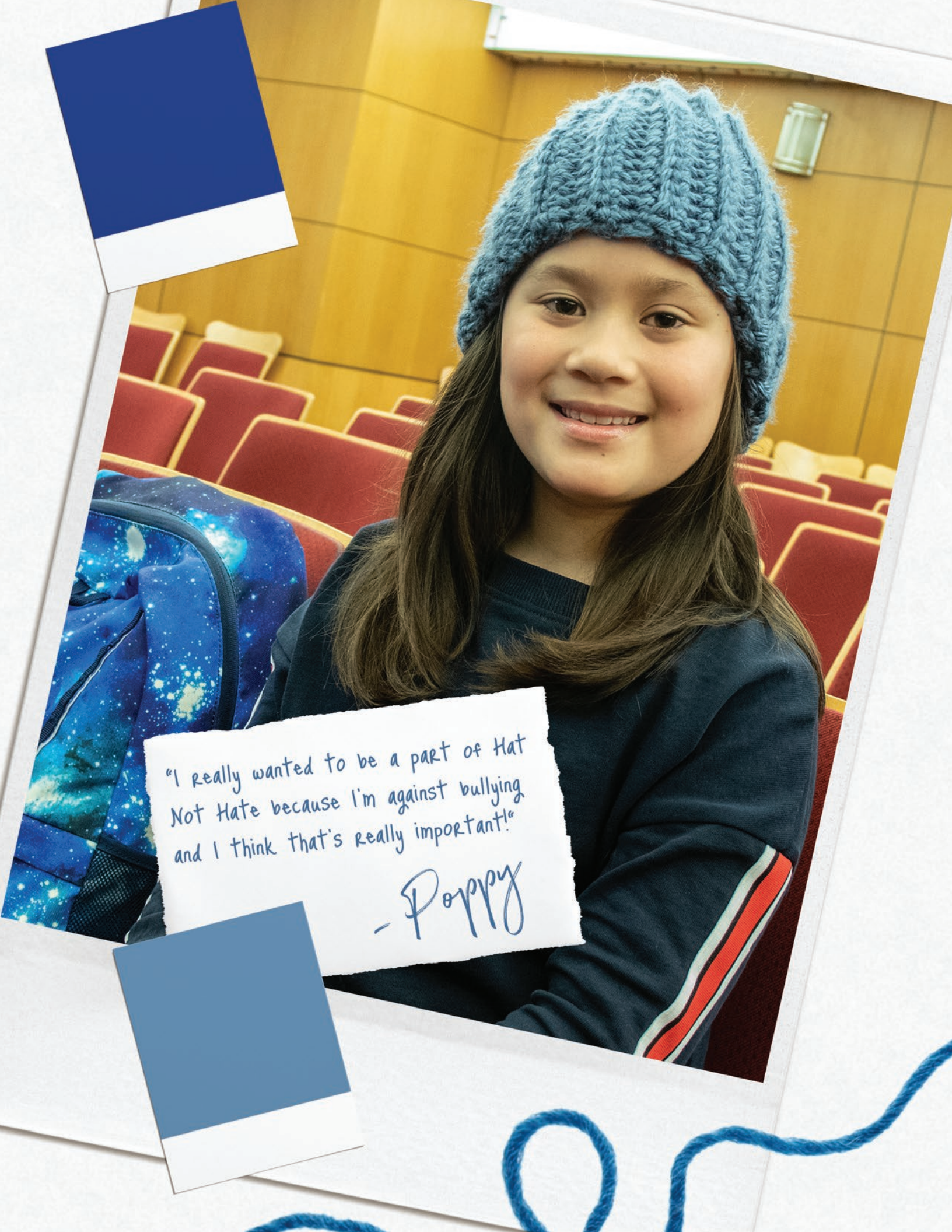

About 20 in. (51 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes

Finished Height
About 9 in. (22.5) cm



GAUGE
9 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm.)
Be sure to check your gauge.

- MATERIALS**
- LION BRAND® HOMETOWN (Art. #135) (Yarn weight CYC #6) # 108 Washington Denim 1 ball
 - LION BRAND® crochet hook size N-13 (9 mm)
 - LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

NOTE
This Hat is worked as flat rectangle and then seamed.

HAT
Chain 22.
Row 1: Sc in 2nd chain from hook and in each ch across – you'll have 21 sc.
Row 2: Chain 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each sc across.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 20 in. (51 cm) from beginning.

Fasten off.
Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

FINISHING
Thread yarn tail into blunt needle. Sew sides of piece together to make the Hat.
Thread another length of yarn into blunt needle, then weave in and out of stitches along one long side of Hat, pull to gather for top of Hat and knot.

Weave in ends.
